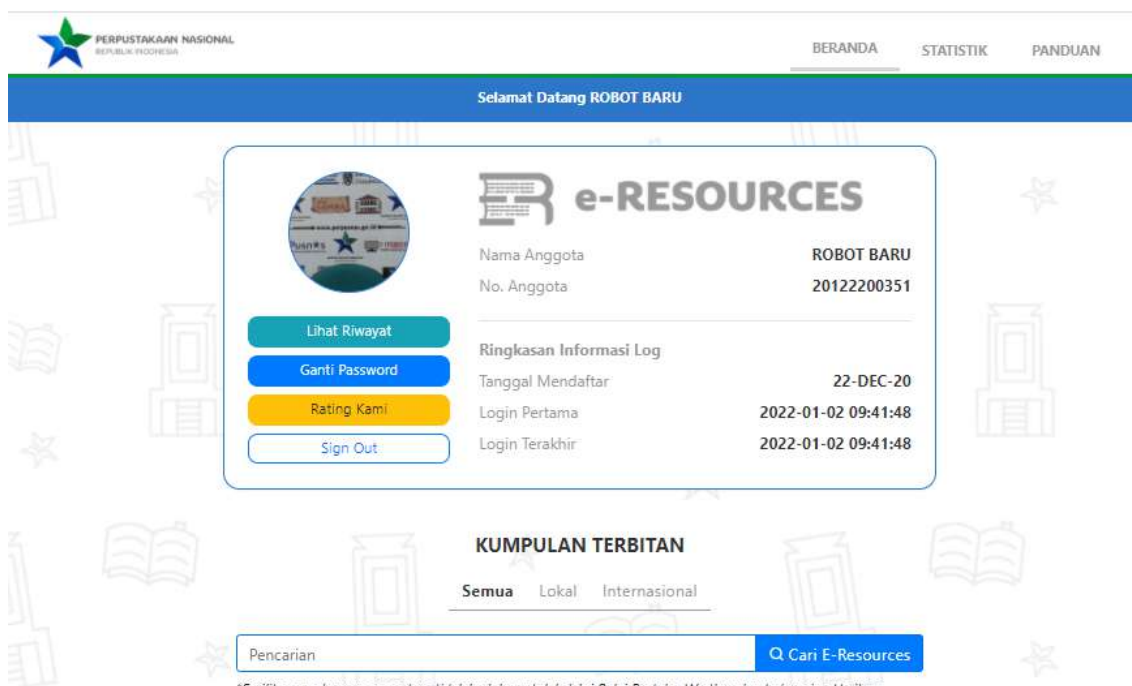

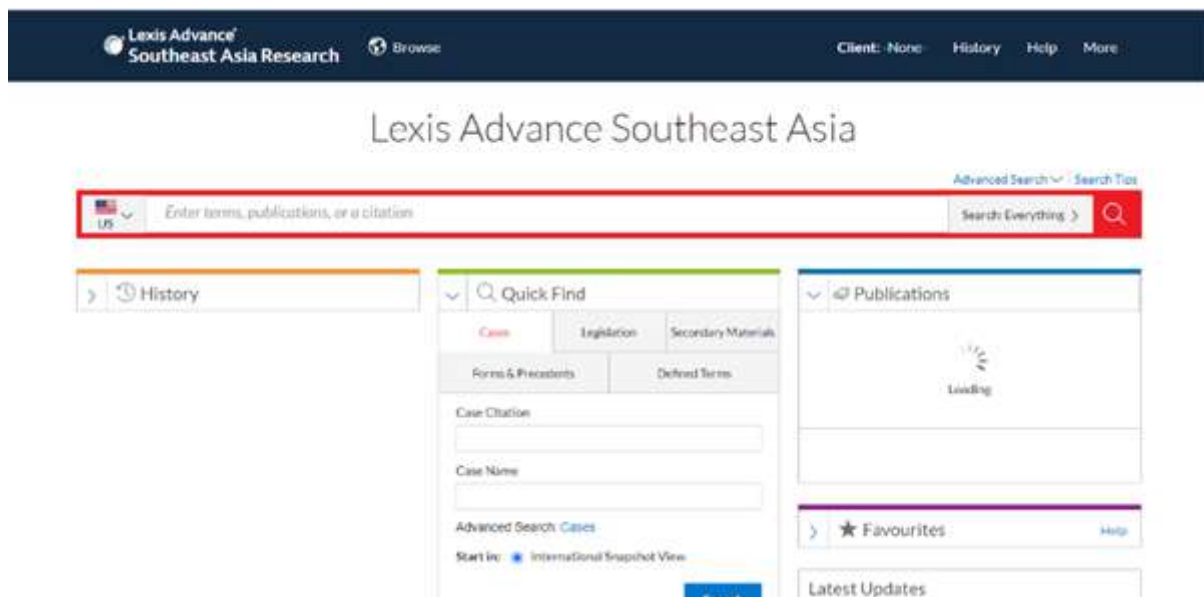

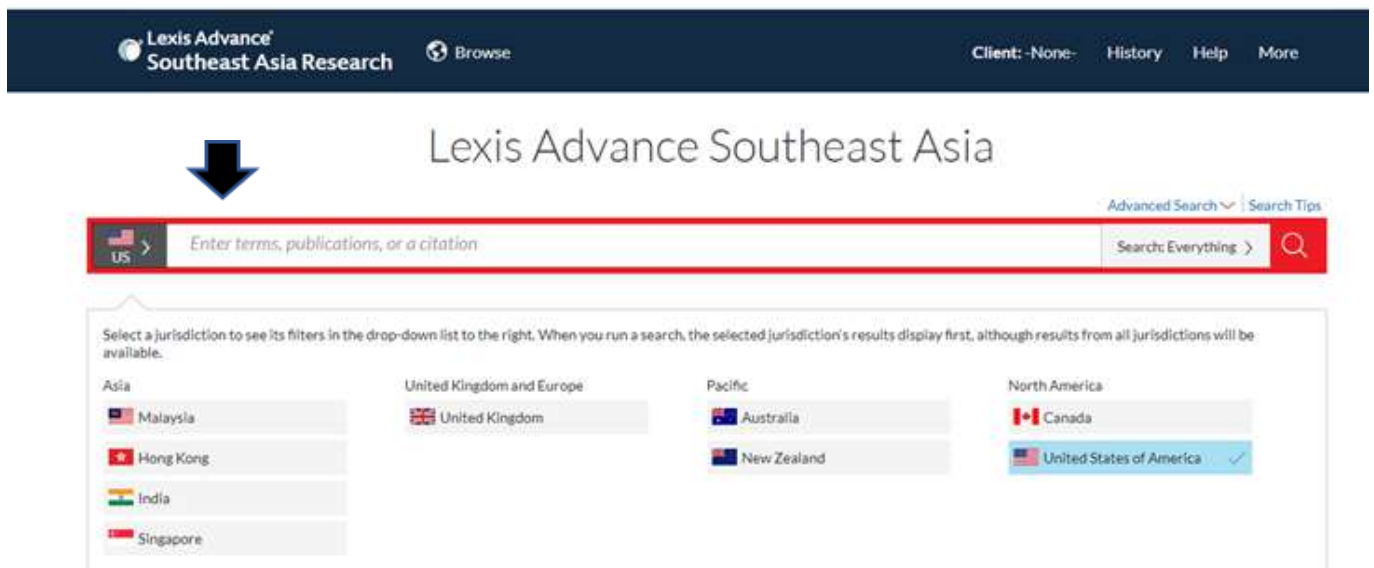

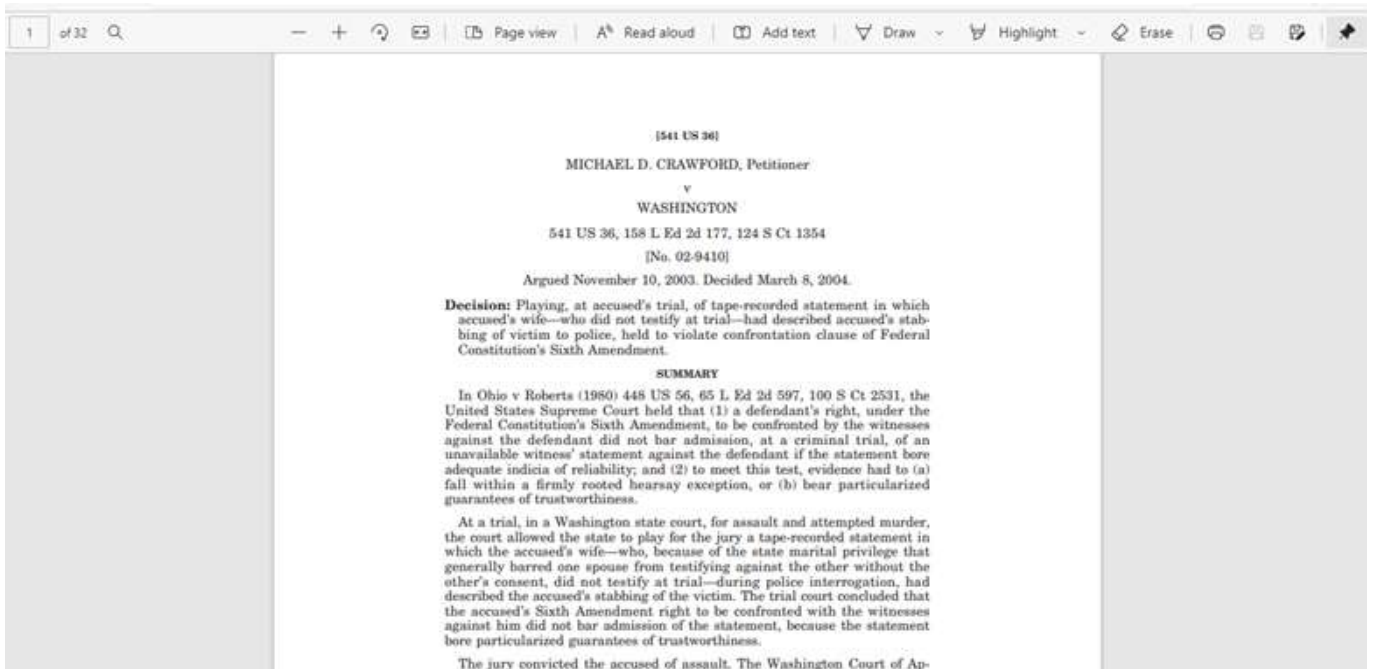
SUMMARY

In *Ohio v. Roberts* (1980) 448 US 56, 65 L. Ed. 2d 597, 100 S Ct 2531, the United States Supreme Court held that (1) a defendant's right, under the Federal Constitution's Sixth Amendment, to be confronted by the witnesses against the defendant did not bar admission, at a criminal trial, of an
